Unused funds must be repaid to swissuniversities by the Swiss higher education institution. The repayment is regulated in detail in a special payment contract.

F. Data Protection

We process the data you provide to assess your application for a grant. This includes in particular the preparation of the documents for review by a group of experts as well as the documentation (especially using candidate lists) for the selection meeting. We will also pass on your complete application dossier (contribution request including attachments) to the expert group. If the data is subject to the Federal Law on Archiving, we will make it available to the Federal Archives and your name can be disclosed to the State Secretariat for Education, Research, and Innovation (SERI). We then use IT service providers (such as Microsoft) to whom we transmit your data. These are partly in Switzerland but can be in any country in the world. Not all these countries have data protection that is appropriate from a Swiss perspective. In such a case, we ensure appropriate protection through adequate contractual agreements (for example standard data protection clauses) unless the service provider is already subject to a legally recognized set of rules to ensure data protection and we cannot rely on an exception provision.
