Purpose and status of this document

The purpose of this specification document is to supplement the guide (Leitfaden/guide) of the State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SERI) for Roadmap 2027 by providing detailed information to the swissuniversities-internal process. The following specifications outline the procedures for collecting and further processing project ideas and two-page proposals at swissuniversities.

The specification document is publicly available on the website of swissuniversities. If the ongoing process for 2027 Roadmap makes it necessary, the document will be adjusted accordingly, and an updated version will be published. The Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) will be informed about news and changes via swissuniversities' website and official communication to the offices of the vice presidents for research if applicable.

Responsibility for Internal Steps at the Higher Education Institutions

According to the established process, information about the internal steps at the higher education institutions (HEIs) is provided by the responsible offices at the respective institutions. Information for projects of the ETH Domain

The ETH Board is the responsible body for research infrastructure projects in the lead of institutions of the ETH Domain. The ETH Board takes its decisions according to its established internal process and in line with SERI's guidelines.

Templates for project ideas and two-page proposals

Researchers must complete a template for each of Phases A and B:

- The template for the two-page proposals will be available for Phase B Prioritisation at a later date (Q1 2025).

Further Notes for researchers on collecting and processing of project ideas and twopage proposals

swissuniversities

The General Secretariat of swissuniversities (GS) provides a SWITCHdrive folder for the vice presidents for research to submit the completed forms for project ideas (by 2 March 2025) and two-page proposals (by 5 May 2025).

After the GS compiles an overview list of the project ideas (by 5 March 2025) and the twopage proposals (by 12 May 2025), it shares these together with the completed forms of the project ideas and two-page proposals via SWITCHdrive with the vice presidents for research (VPsRES).

The General Secretariat of swissuniversities (GS) does not provide information on how the internal processes of HEIs are organized.

Further Notes for researchers on open use of project ideas and two-page proposals

For the means of coordination and prioritisation in Phases A and B, it is necessary to share the project ideas and two-page proposals with the working group of the VPsRES and the relevant swissuniversities bodies (<u>Chamber of universities</u> and <u>Board</u>). Researchers are aware of that their project ideas will be shared. This also applies to project applications submitted to the SNSF and to the evaluation results.

enioruiversities	Second half of 2026	'Binding commitment': Following the SNSF evaluation, a 'binding financial commitment' must be issued by the Rectorate/President's Board prior to the VPsRES' meeting. On this basis, the responsible swissuniversities bodies decide upon the projects for the 2027 Roadmap. What is considered to be a 'binding commitment' will be negotiated amongst VPsRES and/or rectors.
	Second half of 2026	Phase C Pre Selection: Discussion/meeting – VPsRES pre-select projects on the basis of the SNSF evaluation report and the internal selection criteria
	Until end of 2027	swissuniversities selects projects for RM27 on the basis of the financial feasibility assessment in consultation with the responsible HEIs
